Criteria for applicants:

1. Must be a RN or RM who is a financial member of ANFC and working in the continence arena. This encompasses or includes clinician, research, promotion and education roles.
2. Have a significant work history within the continence field and committed approach to helping people with continence issues.
3. A commitment to promoting continence awareness in the community.
4. A dedication to the support and mentoring of colleagues within the industry.
5. 2 references to support application, specifically name, address, e-mail address.

A short CV may be included additionally to support applicant.

Award Details:

1. The winner will receive economy class fares, ICS registration and accommodation in a 3 star hotel to attend the International Conference in Glasgow from 29th - 2nd September 2011.
2. The second winner will receive a contribution of \$500 to attend any conference relative to continence within 12 months of the award being presented.

Award promotion and application process:

Promotion

- Application form posted from ANFC committee to all financial members of ANFC in July 2010. Entries close 30th September 2010. This complies with membership confidentiality.

The nominee must include detailed information about the clinician nominated pertaining to the 5 criteria for applicants as outlined above (maximum around two pages total). A short CV may be included additionally to support the applicant.

Selection process

- A selection panel will be formed annually comprising 3 persons selected from various sectors of the 'continence community'. The decision of the Conni Awards Selection Panel is final and binding.

Expectations of the recipients

- A written report outlining the benefits attained / learning outcomes by attending the conference. The report should be informative with the view that any registered nurse or midwife who reads it will experience a greater knowledge outcome pertaining to continence issues.
- This report will be posted on the Conni website which will have a dedicated page for the CONNI Awards and the ANFC website. The ANFC committee will also make the report available to financial members through e-mail distribution to state and territory representatives for dissemination to local members.

Announcement of award

- At the Annual General Meeting of ANFC held concurrently with the national CFA conference. The recipient of the award will be acknowledged by the President and members of ANFC.
